1st row (k6, k2tog) 9 times k1

2nd and every alternate row Purl

 3rd row
 (k5 k2tog) 9 times k1

 5th row
 (k4 k2tog) 9 times k1

 7th row
 (k3 k2tog) 9 times k1

 9th row
 (k2 k2tog) 9 times k1

 11th row
 (k1 k2tog) 9 times k1

13th row (k2 tog) 9 times k1 (10 stitches)

Break yarn off and run through the remaining stitches to draw up and join the seam.
